- Complete school placements at a minimum of 2 of 3 levels (elementary, middle, high school)
- > Benefit from an emphasis on preventative and remedial classroom guidance, small group, and one-on-one interventions to meet students' academic career, and personal/social needs; as well as assist in post-graduation planning
