

DOCTORAL PROGRAM IN COUNSELOR EDUCATION



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Our doctoral program in counselor education focuses on preparing you to teach counseling-related courses, supervising students, conducting research and participating in service activities related to the preparation of counselors and the advancement of the counseling profession. Our program is also for you if you are interested in pursuing a career in academia and higher education.

In this program you will:

- > Complete a series of three teaching internships designed to develop and focus your teaching philosophy and skills.
- > Develop competencies for leadership and instructional roles in counselor education and supervision, advanced counseling practice and research.
- > Emphasize on research, counseling and skills training as the model for preparation.
- > Learn through peer interactions with other counselor education, counseling and school psychology doctoral students.

Who should enroll in this doctoral program?

The Counselor Education Program is designed for experienced counseling professionals who want a career as a faculty member at the university level. Students develop competencies for leadership and instructional roles in advanced counseling practice counselor education and supervision, and research.
