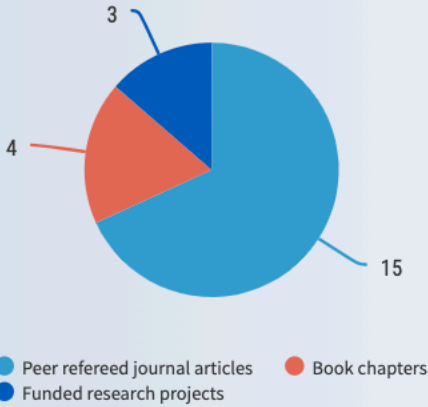

Virtual Annual Conference



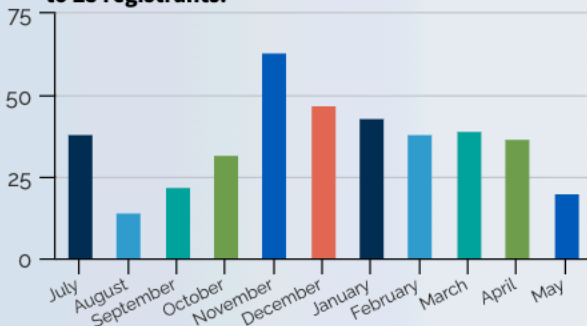
