Mental Health Counseling Program

Curriculum and Course Sequencing

The online and on-campus curricula are identical (60 credit hours), but course sequencing differs by format. Many courses may only be offered **once per year** so any deviation from the sequence **may delay graduation**.

On-Campus Full-Time Course Sequencing

The on-campus format is designed as a full-time program that may be completed in two years (five semesters). On-campus students must attend fall and spring semesters. Standard track students attend only in the fall and spring semesters. Accelerated track students take classes in the fall and spring semesters and the summer session. Online Part-Time Course Sequencing

The online format is designed as a part-time program that may be completed in four years, including two summers. Online students are required to take coursework over two summers. Students will have some classes that regularly meet remotely via Zoom on the scheduled day and time. Students may also need to arrange synchronous meetings or presentations in other courses. To pass these courses, students must attend the scheduled sessions.
