While assisting in Dr. Anderson's lab, I was required to work in both the P.I.P. lab and the OU Psychology and Social Work Clinic. I assisted in the scoring of response videos for data collection and the finalization of the stimulus videos for the FIS Tele-Therapy work. Facilitative Interpersonal Skills are a set of skills utilized by therapists to encourage their clients in emotional and psychological distress to initiate change toward improved well-being. In the past two years, P.I.P. lab has shifted its focus to how FIS can be used within clinical training. The lab has developed training that aims to enhance therapists' FIS, which works on alliance rupture and repair, responsiveness, contextual model integration, and outcome expectations.
