

Prospective Non-Degree Student Information Sheet

This sheet has been prepared for students interested in taking courses in the Department of Counseling, School and Educational Psychology (CSEP) who **have not been formally accepted** to a program.

Students interested in taking classes in CSEP on a non-degree (non-matriculating) basis must complete an online application for non-degree students that can be found at <http://ed.buffalo.edu/academics/courses.html>. In addition to the online application and \$35.00 non-refundable fee, proof of a bachelor's degree is required. Prospective students are required to obtain approval of the instructor of the desired class. Students may take up to 12 credits as a non-degree student. Non-degree students are allowed to enroll (with instructor permission) in the courses below.

Please contact the department before registering for a course to be sure the course is available and will run and avoid losing application fees. CSEP reserves the right to drop a non-matriculated student registered for a course if the spot is needed for a student in a CSEP program.
