

## Initial Teacher Education Student Performance on Licensing Exams

### 2016 – 17 Cohort Data on Educating All Students (EAS)

The following table provides aggregate data for the Educating All Students (EAS) test, which is part of the New York State Teacher Certification Exams (NYSTCE) that are requirements of the New York State Education Department (NYSED) for the issuance of an Initial Teacher Certificate. NYSED had established a score of 520 as the threshold for passing the EAS (with a maximum possible score of 600); however, this was adjusted to 500 during the timeframe of a ‘safety net’ adopted by the New York State Board of Regents in May 2015 (for further information, see <http://www.highered.nysed.gov/tcert/certificate/certexamsafetynetseas.html>).
