

Ability of Completers to be Hired in Education Positions for Which They Have Prepared (initial and advanced levels)

Two recent groups of 2016-2017 program completers were surveyed to determine their employment status after graduating from the University at Buffalo's Teacher Education and Educational Leadership preparation programs.

Group 1) 42 Initial Completers in 2016-2017
The 42 Initial Completers in 2016-2017 provided the following post-graduation employment data:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 25 Students are teaching in PK-12 schools • 4 Students are continuing their education • 3 Students work in field other than education • 10 Students did not provide data
Group 2) 55 Advanced Completers in 2016-2017
The 40 Advanced Teacher Preparation Program Completers in 2016-2017 provided the following post-graduation employment data:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 18 Students are teaching in PK-12 schools • 22 Students did not provide data
The 15 Educational Leadership Preparation Program Completers in 2016-2017 provided the following post-graduation employment data:
