University at Buffalo students release report on benefits of offshore wind turbines

BUFFALO, N.Y. (WIVB) - Some University at Buffalo students are releasing a report on the benefits of the offshore wind turbines on Lake Erie.

The report is urging New York State leaders to develop a plan for production of clean, renewable offshore wind power from the wind turbines.

The report says New York should take advantage of the enormous potential to harness offshore wind power.

University at Buffalo clinic student Dwight Kanyuck said, "Developing this resource in an environmentally sound manner could enable western New York to become a leader in off shore wind energy and component manufacturing."

The UB report also urges state leaders to provide financial incentives to companies to encourage the development of the state's Great Lakes wind power.
